OTIP's Early Intervention program is a union supported service that provides confidential and valuable assistance to members during the early stages of a medically-related work absence.

We provide resources and education specific to your medical condition with a focus on recovery and a timely return to work.



The Early Intervention program can help:

Provide resources for evidence-based treatment and services.

Educate about treatments specific to your condition.

Expedite and explain diagnostic tests.

Support with return-to-work strategies and procedures.

What to expect

Step one:

OTIP receives a notice of absence from your union/school board.



Step two:

You will receive an email or phone call from an Early Intervention Coordinator to discuss the Early Intervention program.



Step three:

You will be referred to an Early Intervention Rehabilitation Consultant who will work closely with you to provide an individualized action plan.



Frequently asked questions

What if I do not require assistance from Early Intervention?

The program is voluntary. If you do not require our support or services, simply reply to our initial email sent from an Early Intervention Coordinator to let us know.

Is there a cost to access the Early Intervention program?

The EI program is a complimentary service included in your Long Term Disability Plan to facilitate needs and support early in your absence. There is no cost for this program.
